BE IT REMEMBERED that I, Richard F. Varney of Gilmanton, in the County of Belknap and State of New Hampshire, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

FIRST: I direct that all of my just debts and my funeral expenses be paid as soon as practicable after my decease.

SECOND: To the Trustees of Trust Funds of the Town of Gilmanton, I give and devise a tract of about one acre of land adjacent to the Friends' Cemetery, so-called, and conveyed in 1946 by William C. Clarke, Jr. to me and my brother, George B. Varney, recently deceased, as joint tenants, for the purpose of protecting and improving said Cemetery; together with Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) to be invested and the income therefrom used for the care and maintenance of the Friends' Cemetery and the tract of land devised by me by this paragraph.

THIRD: I direct my executor to cancel the \$1,000.00 note of the Peaked Hill Fire Department held by me, to discharge the mortgage given to secure it, to cause the discharge of the mortgage to be recorded in the Registry of Deeds, and to deliver the note and mortgage to the Fire Department.

FOURTH: To C. F. Jeffrey of Lynn, Massachusetts, I give and bequeath five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).

FIFTH: To George C. Brown of Gilmanton, I give and bequeath five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).

SIXTH: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, whether real, personal, or mixed, wheresoever found and howsoever situate, after the payment therefrom of all lawful estate, legacy, inheritance and succession taxes imposed on my estate or by virtue of any provision contained herein or in any codicil hereto, I give, devise and bequeath to Harland N. McEwen and Anna R. McEwen, of said Gilmanton, jointly, or to the survivor of them.

SEVENTH: I hereby constitute and appoint William S. Lord of Gilford, N.H. executor of this my last will and testament, and request that he be not required to furnish bond beyond the minimum amount required by law.
