BUZZELL CEMETERY: take Route 11-A toward West Alton, 1 mi. past Gunstock Recreation Area, Bickford Rd. is on same side as the Area. Directly opposite is the old BUZZELL farm and Cemetery.

Buzzell Cemetery

From my aunt's records 1937

ICHABOD BUZZELL July 17, 1740-July 22, 1828 88 yrs

Buried on his farm in Gilmanton, N.H. where he went about 1773. His grave is marked with a flag. The farm is located on the mountain road which leads from Gilford Village, N.H. toward Alton, and joins the Lake Shore Rd just below West Alton. It is on the left hand side of the road going down the hill. There are no buildings - only remains of a house cellar and well - but in the corner of the field are a number of graves and Ichabod's is marked each year by the DAR chapter of Laconia N.H. (her records were as of 1937)

Tuck Library in Concord NH has a mss. showing that Ichabod Buswell (Busell, Buzzell) enlisted in the Provincial Service in 1760.

Apparently served in the French and Indian War for several years.

No record of Revolutionary War service

Records of owning land in Barrington prior to coming to Gilmanton.

His son was

JOHN ROBERTS BUZZELL born 1774 at Gilmanton, N.H.
Married Rachel Smith 1798 at Gilmanton. She was born 1780 at Gilmanton

John Roberts was my great grandfather.

Between these two, seventeen of their combined offspring bearing their name might have been buried around Gilmanton; or gone to school or have been involved around there Your finds must be descendants of these children.
