Engineering March 1959, indicated that: "there is no significant advantage to be gained by working at or below zero intake pressure (or vacuum) on the pumper." The test results indicated that even by running the pumps at undesirable engine speeds to the point of cavitation; water delivery was increased only 3%. From the foregoing comments, it can be seen that there is little likelihood, under normal conditions, that water mains in the street would be collapsed by a pumper operating at negative suction pressures.

1983: Purchased large oval dinner plates, regular B & B plates, 10 oz foam chowder bowls, 6 oz foam butter bowls (cheaper and keep butter warm longer), 10 oz foam cups, regular dinner napkins, wet knaps, 1 roll of table covering (takes atleast one full and maybe a little extra to do all tables) and 2½ oz portion cups.

As always, had about 1-1½ gallons of butter left. I think we could try buying only 21 marg and 21 butter and have enough. We had about 10 lbs of melted left over this year.

1984: Ok, but George didn't bring anything until 4p.m. We had to make do on what we needed to set up. Butter was also late for melting and we had to serve with some still hard. Get paper goods a couple of weeks early. We always have to make do with something a little different than what we really want. Pick up the linen!! Forgot it for a year again.

1986: Bought 31 marg and 11 butter. Used 11 butter and 21 marg for customers and 10 marg for help. Seemed to go well, good amt. Do neet 1-2 pkg of SOS pads for pits. Should be enough raffle tickets for next year. Should be enough salt, pepper and sugar packets for next year. Should find something weighted to serve them in though. Foam cups blow over easily.

Lots of dinner and B&B plates left, 100-200 of each. Used most of bowls. Lots of cups left, one case or more. Get 100 extra napkins next year, always run out. Get paper table covering, it's cheaper, worked ok. Will need box of 55 gal liners. Find someplace to buy large, heavy plastic bags for food. Zip locks are expensive and used 4 boxes of them this year. Won't need any more portion cups.
