


MOROCCO shop No 1 during the 1936 flood




MCROCCO shop No 2 down by the Center Railroad yard

HODGDON

1. CHARLES HODGDON son of JOHN HODGDON of Newington N.H. He settled on the Province road where HAYWARD green house is now. Near Lily lake in 1768. 1790 town census 2 boys and 2 girls. In 1796 he was chosen to erect a meeting house in the Parade. A justice of the peace. A deacon of the Parade church for many years. He had the first post office. He ran a boarding house and stable. He was born in 1740 and died in 1817. His lst wife HANNAH DENNETT, she was born in 1743 and died in 1790. A sister of MOSES DENNETT. His 2nd wife ABIGATL THYNG was born in 1747 and died in 1830. They are buried in a cemetery near the home place, next to route 107. He was town selectman for 6 years.

His wife POLLY EMERSON was born in 1777 and died in 1858. She came from Durham N.H. They are buried in DANIEL BUNKER cemetery.




