She had been a shoe worker at H.O. Rondeau Shoe in Farmington.

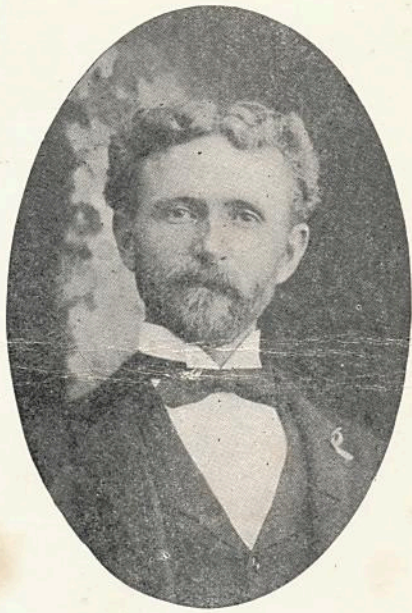
