Lougee, John (1)

was born 1700 in the Isle of Jersey and came to this country at the age of eighteen. In 1710 he served in a scouting party in pursuit of savages, under Captain Gilman. He was captured by the Indians, but made his escape. He was by trade a knitter, and he settled in Exeter, N.H., where he died at the age of 77. He married Mary Gilman, daughter of Moses Gilman of New Market. They had eight children.

John (2) eldest child of John and Mary (Gilman) Lougee, was born in Exeter. He married (first) Molly Leavitt, by whom he had Sarah, John, Nehemiah, Jesse, Molly, Jonathan, Elsey, William. 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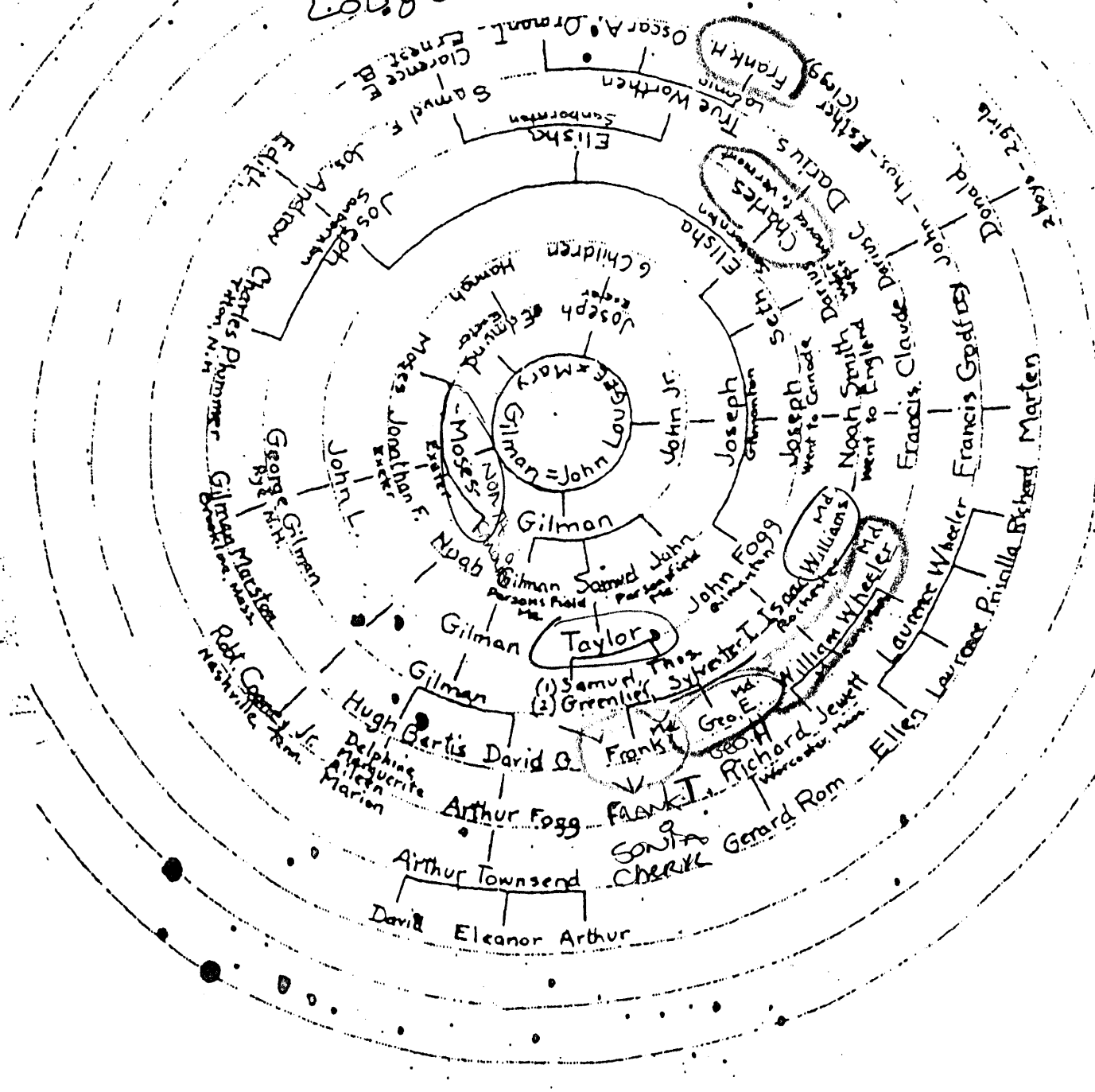

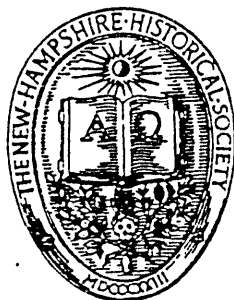

JOHN LOUGEE AND SOME OF HIS DESCENDANTS

Condensed from a study by WINIFRED LOVERING HOLMAN, of Boston, Mass.

The following account of the first three generations of the Lougee family should be considered as merely the basis for a more complete and extended genealogy, since it has not been possible to search exhaustively for vital records, wills and deeds pertaining to the fourth and succeeding generations. Hence, with one exception, this account has been limited to the genealogy of John Lougee, the immigrant, his children and grandchildren.

Because of the limitation of space, many quotations from and abstracts of original documents have been left out of the record as published herewith. Although these add to the life-histories of the several members of the family, they are not essential to the establishment of relationship between them. They are, however, included in the original typescript which is on file in the Society's manuscript collection, where they may be examined by those interested in following members of the family in more detail.

I regret that I have been unable to study in detail the material on this family collected by Miss F. Marion Lougee of Lewiston, Maine, who visited me when I was living in Lexington, Mass. We have exchanged letters and talked on the telephone; she granted me the privilege of using two family charts. A more thorough examination of her material might have enabled us both to avoid some duplication in research. Miss Lougee is continuing her search for records, especially in the Isle of Jersey, hoping to identify 'our' John Lougee and determine his parentage and ancestry. She has assured me that she will ultimately deposit her notes in the Society's manuscript collection. She is referred to in this article as F.M.L.

All who use this record of John Lougee are indebted to Robert Grizzard Cooney, Jr., of Nashville, Tenn., a member of the Society, for his generosity in permitting the publication of this work which I have done for him. He is a descendant of Noah Lougee, the only member of the fourth generation whose record is included herein.

I cannot conclude without attempting to express my appreciation to my husband, Frank Riley Dodge, Rear Admiral, U.S.N. (ret.), not only for his patience and consideration for me while I have been compiling this genealogy from my notes, but also for his insistence

Tuesday I attended the Funeral of old Mrs. Smith—she died on Sunday night—this day Esq. Porters Daughter Betty came here (carried till Satterday) Wednesday night came here Cousin Elisha Olcott of Hartford—he set out for home on Fryday.

October 29. Mr. Hop from Revelations 2 and 7. In the after-noon Mr. Peirce preacht (to help Mr. Hop being weak) from Psalms 11 ver 2. Monday Mrs. Bartlett came here. Thursday Wor. went to Belcher—in the after-noon my mama Rode into town at night returned. Fryday Sarah Goodrich made a visit here—this day Wor. got home—in the Evening he went and brought Silence Bartlett here to taylor for him. Last Wednesday Miss Joanna set out for home.

November 5. Mr. Hop sick—Deacon Smith made the first prayer—Deacon (Or Esq) Porter read one of Dr. Dodridges sermons from Ephesians 2 ch. 1 and 2 ver. Mr. Dickingson made the last prayer. In the after-noon Deacon Porter made the first prayer—Lawyer Porter read another of them sermons upon Regeneration from Corrinthians [blank] Mr. Dick. made the last prayer. Tuesday one Mr. Colton of Longmeadow a kinsman of ours came here and a young one with him. Wednesday they set for home and Silence Bartlett went home also.

Novem. 12. Sunday no preaching. Deacon Porter read in the fore-noon. Lawyer Porter in the after-noon. Wednesday I Rode into town. Thursday Thanksgiving-day Mr. Hop from [blank] I went in the Eve—returned on Satterday. Fryday Worthington and his Little Gib set out for Colchester.

November 19. Sunday Mr. Hop from [blank] Tuesday Esq. Porters wife and Sally Goodrich, Miss Pen and Patty and Betty came here to help quilt—we got of two coats by Wednesday night—in the morning they returned. (Mrs. Porter went home on Tuesday night.)

November 26. Sunday Mr. Hop from [blank] This day I am two and Twenty years old; Gods Goodness has spared me thus far; may it make me better as well as spare me to grow older. Wednesday Eve. Wor. returned in safety. Fryday Silence Bart. came here to work. Satterday returned.

December 3. Sunday Mr. Hop from Jeremiah 31, 25. This day my mother tarried in town. Monday night Polly came here to tarry. Miss pen and her Brother Nehemiah also with etc. [sic] spent the Evening here. Tuesday Peg went to Amherst. Wednesday Worth. carried Polly home and brought my mama—this night Peg returned. Thursday Tabithy Clark came here to taylor. Satterday returned. Fryday Lecture before the Sacramento Worth. at meeting—Mr. Hop from Issiah [sic] 49, v. 1.

December 10. Sunday Sacramento day. Mr. Hop from Jeremiah 23 ch. 6 ver. The Lord our Righteousness. Monday Lawyer Porter came here and brought his wife and three children—just at night Mr. Hop came here and brought his wife. She tarried—the rest went home—in the night she was took poorly—very ill by morning Worth. carried her home. Wednesday Eve. Worth. went into town—I rode in with him—I spent the Eve at Lawyer Porters—came home. Thursday Mr. Parsons of Amherst and his wife came here, he went to Hatfield to a Fast appointed on account of Mr. Woodbridges illness. Fryday he came back and went home and Mrs. Parsons went to Hatfield to keep Sabbath. Miss Becca Dickson here for visit satterday—Mr. Parsons came here to go to Hatfield to preach for Mr. Holibird who went to Amherst to preach.

that I "keep at it" even though it meant his endurance of me while I have been in the painful throes of "writing them up."

Lougee (pronounced with a soft 'g') is found in New Hampshire records spelled in a variety of ways: Loge, Logee, Logie, Looge, Loug, Louge, Lougee, Lougie, Lowgee and Lowger: it has been misread and consequently misprinted as Lang, Lange, Langee, Long, Longe and Longee.

All places mentioned in this account of the family are in New Hampshire, unless otherwise noted.

1. JOHN¹ LOUGEE, cordwainer, probably born in Jersey in the Channel Islands about 1682-1685, died before 1769 when land belonging to his father-in-law's estate was distributed and he may have died about 1761.¹ He was living in Exeter as late as 12 Jan. 1756, when he and his wife Anne sold some land.

He married in Exeter, probably about 1718, ANNE GILMAN, daughter of Moses Gilman by his wife Ann, daughter of Ensign James and Shuah (Starbuck) Gilman. She survived her husband and may have been living 1 Feb. 1771 (see below). Heard

John Lougee is said to have come to New England "in the time of Queen Anne's War," which began in 1702.¹ The earliest record of him is found in a deed given by Lt. Nicholas Gilman of Exeter, which he witnessed 12 March 1702/3.²

His name is found on the muster roll of Capt. Nicholas Gilman's company as one of a party of scouts who served for three days, 21-23 June 1710. He is said to have been captured by the Indians during the war, taken to Canada, sent to England, and to have "returned in 1716."³ He was, however, in Exeter 12 June 1714, when he signed a receipt for a debt due him from the estate of Edward Sewall,⁴ so this story of his capture and imprisonment, if true, may have become distorted.

Since he bought a house and lot from Benjamin Rogers of Exeter, 2 April 1718, he was probably married or about to take a wife.⁵ This, he and his wife, Ann, sold in 1723, she releasing her right of dower.⁶ When the town ordered the distribution of some land, 12 April 1725, John Lougee was among those who benefited, and received thirty acres.⁷

He and his wife, one of the heirs of [redacted] Gilman, were involved in the following transaction:

3 July 1729, "To all Christian People . . . Greeting Know Y^e that we Moses Gilman Sen^r and Moses Gilman Jun^r of Exeter in the Province of New Hampshire Husbandmen John Lord of said Exeter Joyner & Abigail his Wife John Longee of s^d Exeter Cordwa^r & Anne his Wife Nicholas Smith of said Exeter Cordwainer and Judath his Wife Abner Thurston of said Exeter Cordwainer & Shuah his Wife & Eliz^t Gilman Dat^t of said Moses Gilman a Singlewoman for . . . Twenty Pounds . . . paid . . . by Nathan Bartlet of Kittery in the County of York Tanner & Province of the Massachusetts Bay . . . confirm unto the said Nathan Bartlet his Heirs and Assigns forever all the Estate . . . w^{ch} we the said Moses Gilman Sen^r Moses Gilman jun^r John Lord & Abigail Lord John Lougee & Anne Lougee Nicholas Smith & Judith Smith Abner Thursten and Shuah Thursten & Eliz^t Gilman have . . . unto . . . the Real & Personal Estate of James Heard of Kittery afores^d Deceased Father in Law to me said Moses Gilman Sen^r & Grand father to us the said Moses Gilman

Ju' John Lord & Abigail Lord John Longee and Anne Longee Nicholas Smith & Judah Smith Abner Thurston and Shuah Thurston & Eliz^a Gilman both of that real & Personal Estate wth the said James Heard Died possessed of & also of in & unto the Real and personal Estate he ought to have been in Possession of both within the Town of Kittery aforesaid or any other place whatever . . . In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our Hands & Seals . . . [Signed by] Moses Gilman, Moses Gilman ju', John Lord Abigail [X] Lord, John Loge Ann [X] Logee, Nicholas Smith, Judeth [X] Smith, Abner Thurstin, Shuah [X] Thustin and Elizabeth [X] Gilman. [All the grantors acknowledged it on same day, except Moses Gilman, Jr., who appeared on 7 July 1729], received 25 March 1737.⁸

Moses Gilman, the "Sr" of the above document, drew his will in Exeter 4 April 1741 and named, among his other heirs, his daughter, Anne Lougee.⁹

Since John Lougee's name does not appear in any of the printed records pertaining to the Church in Exeter, it seems that he was not a member.¹⁰ Nor does he appear to have held any public office, although John Lougee, Jr., was the hog reeve in 1747.

The last public reference to John Lougee seems to be a deed, dated 12 Jan. 1756, wherein he and his wife, Anne, disposed of land received from her father, Moses Gilman.¹¹

The division of the estate of Moses Gilman [III], Anne's brother, was made 1 Feb. 1771, and mentions land set off to "The Widow Looge as part of her father's estate."¹² This proves that John Lougee was dead by 1769 and implies that his widow was still living in 1771, although it does not prove conclusively that she was.

Of their nine children, all but four bear names from the Gilman family: of these four John was named for his father and Joseph, Edmund and Joanna may have been Lougee names. Perhaps John's father was either Joseph or Edmund, although the latter is sometimes found as a form of Edward, which was the name of Anne's great-grandfather.

2. JOHN² LOUGEE (*John*¹), probably the eldest son of John and Anne (Gilman) Lougee, born in Exeter about 1719, died in Gilmanton in December 1794, as "Old Mr. Lougee."

He married first, probably in Exeter, about 1744, MOLLY LEAVITT, died about 1761; secondly, probably there, about 1762, SUSAN HULL, died before 1789; and thirdly, as her fourth husband, in Gilmanton, 11 Nov. 1789, JUDITH (—) (JACKSON) (CHATTLE) BEALE, died in June 1836, aged ninety-seven, widow of — Jackson, Thomas Chattle and Thomas Beale.

He is said to have been a clothier, trader and innholder. Between 1744 and 1747 there are several deeds and other records in which he was called John Lougee, Jr. In 1755 John Lougee was a tithingman: this probably refers to him, rather than his father who was then alive. He continued to hold office in Exeter until 1768 at least. But by 1773 he was living in Gilmanton, where he and his wife, "Susane," were among those who formed, 16 Nov. 1773, the Baptist Church.¹³ He does not appear as the head of a family in the First Federal Census of 1790, so at that time he was probably living with one of his children, perhaps his son Henry.

Obviously this Emerson¹ and his son, Emerson,⁴ and some of their families, as the last four stones are adjacent to each other.

3. JOSEPH² LOUGEE (John¹), tailor, born probably in Exeter about 1723, died in Gilmanton in May 1794, as "Old Mr. Lougee."

He married first, probably in Exeter, before 27 March 1745, ELIZABETH SCRIBNER, died 30 Sept. 1774, aged forty-nine years, as "Mrs. Elizabeth Looge," wife of Joseph, buried in Exeter, daughter of Joseph and Lydia (—) Scribner; and secondly, by 1787, LYDIA LAMSON, living in Gilmanton 25 May 1794, his widow, daughter of William and Joanna (Tuttle) Lamson. She may have been the Mrs. Lougee who died in Gilmanton in January 1811. Elizabeth (Scribner) Lougee was admitted to the church in Exeter 13 Sept. 1758.

Joseph appears in the town records of Exeter from 1744; as "Lougee" a hayward, 26 March 1744; as "Loge" a tithingman, 25 March 1745; as "Looge" in a petition on ministers' salaries, 30 May 1750; as "Louge" (office not given), 31 March 1755; as "Lougee" on a list of ministers' rates, 7 April 1755; as "Louge Jur [?]" a Surveyor of highways, 28 March 1757; as "Louge" a hogreeve or hayward, 25 March 1765; as "Louge" a "hog Reaf or field driver," 31 March 1766; same spelling of the name and same office, 30 March 1767.

When on 24 May 1756 Elizabeth, the widow, renounced the administration of the estate of Joseph Scribner, Jr., of Exeter, in favor of the deceased's father, Joseph Scribner, the witnesses were "Joseph Lougee" and Robert Lord; the same day the administrator was bonded with Joseph Lougee, tailor, and Noah Emery, gentleman, all of Exeter, as the sureties. Administration was then granted to Joseph Lougee, of same, tailor, 26 Oct. 1757, who had John Steele and John Glidden as sureties. The final settlement of the estate was presented 7 April 1760 and was allowed.¹⁴

It is probable that he moved from Exeter to Canterbury after the death of his first wife in 1774, and thence to Gilmanton in 1789. One Joseph Lougee appears on the tax lists of Canterbury in 1777 and 1778; and Joseph and Joseph, Jr., in 1785. F.M.L. adds that they were both in the lists of 1782 and 1786, but after the latter date only one Joseph appears, presumably Joseph, Jr.

In his will, dated 26 Nov. 1790 and proved 9 June 1794, he

named his wife Lydia, his sons Joseph, Simeon, Nicholas, John and Pitt, his daughters Lidea and Betty.¹⁵

4. [REDACTED] (John¹), joiner, born probably in Exeter about 1727, died there before 16 April 1785.

He married about 1748 LYDIA FOLSOM, born in Exeter about 1730, died before 19 April 1785, daughter of Jonathan and Anna (Ladd) Folsom.

As a young man Moses Lougee served in Captain Light's Company in the expedition against Louisbourg in 1745.¹⁷ In 1755 he was one of those who signed a petition regarding the minister's rate, as he did on several later occasions. He was a surveyor of "shingels" in 1766; served on the grand jury in 1768, and as a petit juror in 1772. His name occurs in the town minutes in other instances through 1775. In that same year he paid a highway tax in Exeter.

On 18 Oct. 1749 Moses Lougee, joiner, and Lydia his wife, formerly "Lydia froulsam" daughter of Jonathan, late of Exeter, conveyed their rights in a forty-acre lot at Crawley's Falls, formerly granted to Mr. John Folsom and Mr. John Light, John Folsom being the grandfather of Lydia.¹⁸ Sixteen years later, 15 Oct. 1765, he and his wife Lydia joined with the other children and coheirs of the late Jonathan Folsom of Exeter in conveying land which he owned in Gilmanton.¹⁹

The date of Moses Lougee's death has not been found, but on 16 April 1785 a petition was filed, asking that Jonathan Lougee administer the estate of his father, deceased, and three days later he was appointed administrator of the estate of his late mother, Lydia Lougee, of Exeter. An inventory of her property was taken the next day, whereas that of Moses was not completed until August 1786, it consisting of just personal property.²⁰

This leads to the conclusion that he was not married.
vi. MOSES, bapt. 27 July 1760; d. s.p. in 1829, aged 73, a member of the Canterbury Family of Shakers. He served in the War as a fifer, 1775-1783.²³

5. GILMAN² LOUGEE (John¹), tailor, born in Exeter 3 Feb. 1729, died in Gilmanton 28 June 1811.
He married perhaps in Kingston, 22 Nov. 1752, SUSANNA MUDGETT, born (? 4 or 5 March, or 5 June) 1737, died in Gilmanton 4 Jan. 1811. Her birth and parentage have not been determined.

Gilman Lougee witnessed the will of Jonathan Thing of Brentwood 27 March 1760. In June of that same year he bought 116 acres of land in Nottingham. And on 15 Oct. 1761 he purchased fifty acres in Gilmanton.²⁴ Tradition has it that he moved to Gilmanton in March 1763, his wife and older children trudging along beside him through the snow. There he became the town's first tailor. In 1770 he was one of the petitioners for a new road. When the Baptist Church was formed in 1773 he became one of the early members. In 1776 he and his son Gilman refused to sign the Association Test and henceforth were considered loyalists. He appears in the 1790 Census as Gillman Lougee, and in 1810 was still listed as the head of a family, his wife being the only other member of the household.

Before Gilman settled in Gilmanton he appeared in these land records:

20 June 1760. Robert Kelse [Kelsey] of Nottingham, yeoman, for £930, sold to Gilman Lougee of the Province of N. H., 116 acres being whole lot #14, 2d range, except 100 acres, in Nottingham; signs as "Kelse;" wit: Robert Harvey and Abner Clough; acknowledged 31 March 1761; recorded 4 Nov. 1761 (*N. H. Province Deeds*, 65:242).

15 Oct. 1761 Aaron Rawlings and Jonathan Robinson of "Brintwood" for £100 sold to Gilman Lougee, of same, tailor, 50 acres in Gilmanton, one half of lot #8, 1st range; sign; wit: Samuel Gilman, Jr., and Lydia Gilman; acknowledged 17 Oct. 1761; recorded 4 Nov. 1761 (*ibid.*, 65:240).

16 April 1762 "I Gilman Lougee of Brentwood . . . Taylor" for £800, o.t., convey to "Benjamin Foulsham" of Nottingham, yeoman, 80 acres in latter town; signs as "Gilman Lougee," wit: Nath¹ Trask and Prnel (? Parnel) Trask; acknowledged same day; recorded 19 Sept. 1817 (*Rockingham Deeds*, 214:533).

3 May 1762 "I Gilman Lougee of y^e Parish of Brentwood," tailor, for £800, o.t., convey to Nathaniel Smith, of Epping, 80 acres in Nottingham purchased of Robert Kelsey of Nottingham, as per his deed to me, 20 June 1760, and being part of lot 14; signs as "Gilman Lougee," wit: Nicholas

Gilman and Joshua Bean; acknowledged 2 Dec. 1762; recorded 19 Sept. 1817 (*ibid.*, 215:15).

The 1762 sales were recorded fifty-five years later. The name does not appear in the indexes to deeds in Exeter, grantor and grantee, 1771-1820 (*Rockingham Deeds*). We do find the name in the indexes in Dover, 1773-1817 only (*Strafford Deeds*).

A manuscript received in 1951 by the New England Historic Genealogical Society, part of the Weeden Collection, S.E.-Wee-7-77, deals with some of the descendants of Gilman Lougee, to which those interested are referred.

Gilman Lougee, of Gilmanton, tailor, drew his will 8 June 1807 (proved 13 July 1811), in which he named wife Susanna; son Simeon; the four children of son Gilman dec'd.; the two children of daughter Molly Ross dec'd.; sons: Samuel, John and Jonathan; daughters: Susanna Dudley, Anna Edgerly, Betty Rundlett and Lydia Lougee; son Simeon to serve as executor. It was witnessed by Simeon Mudgett, Nathan Morrill and David S. Young.

vi. SIMEON, b. about 1763; living 8 June 1807, when he was named executor of his father's will. Perhaps he who m. in Barnstead, 7 Feb. 1813, Polly Edgerly of Gilmanton. The wife of Simeon, b. in Gilmanton, d. in Barnstead 4 Dec. 1850, aged 72. There is no Simeon in Gilmanton in the 1790 Census; the 1800 schedule is missing; in 1810 in Gilmanton Simeon Lougee headed a family of one male over 45, one female, 26-45, one male and three females, 10-16 and one male and two females under 10. F.M.L. suggests he was the tailor of Gilmanton. We lack the names of Simeon¹ Lougee's children. In the Barnstead Parade Cemetery are these gravestones, which may represent his son and his family: Simeon, d. 22 May 1891, aged 85 years 9 months; Mary G., w. of Simeon, d. 29 Apr. 1879, aged 69; John G., son of Simeon and Mary W., d. 1 Feb. 1873, aged 25 years 3 months. The following may have been his daughters: Betsey, m. in Barnstead, 3 July 1814, Samuel Woodman of Alton; Lydia, m. in Barnstead, 31 Oct. 1819, Joseph Young; Polly of Barnstead, m. there, 11 Nov. 1812, Stephen Durgin of Pittsfield.

20. JONATHAN FOLSOM⁸ LOUGEE⁹ (Moses,² John¹), joiner and eldest son, baptized in Exeter 18 Nov. 1753, died there intestate by 9 April 1814.

He married there, 6 Feb. 1783, NANCY THOMPSON,¹⁰ baptized there 6 June 1762, died there 5 Feb. 1852, aged ninety years, daughter of John and Anna (Miller) Tompson.

Like his brothers, Jonathan served in the Revolution.[†]

A study of the census records of Exeter show that Jonathan had another family living with him. As "Jonathan Folsom Lougee," in 1790, he headed a family of two males over 16, one under 16 and five females. In 1800 as Jonathan F. he had a household consisting of one male and one female over 45, one female, 26-45, two females, 10-16 and two males under 10. As Jonathan in 1810 his household consisted of one male and one female over 45, one female, 26-45, two females, 16-26, and one male under 10. Possibly his brother John's family lived with him part of this time.

⁸Thompson or Tompson her name has been misprinted as "Simpson" in Bell, *op. cit.*, but the official record gives "Tompson."

⁹See *Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors in the Revolutionary War*, vol. 9, p. 93, under Joseph Louge, and p. 286, two entries under Jonathan Lougee; also *Rolls of the Soldiers in the Revolutionary War*, vol. 2, p. 748 (New Hampshire State Papers, vol. 13).

The fact that an account, dated 1798, in the estate of Jonathan's brother, Capt. Noah, includes a payment to Nancy "Thompson" is of interest. Noah died between 1791 and 1793 and Jonathan married in 1783 Nancy "Tompson." Did this account refer to the latter's mother, Anna (Miller) Tompson, who may have acted as a nurse or housekeeper to the mariner?

Jonathan had few deeds recorded in Exeter:

He bought brother Moses' share of their mother's rights in 1785. In 1790 Jonathan bought land of Thomas Wilson; and in 1792 from Jonathan Folsom; in 1791 Jonathan F. sold property to James Rundlett. In 1813 Jonathan, of Exeter, with wife Nancy, sold land to Kinsley Hall and signed himself Jonathan F. Lougee (Rockingham County Deeds).

Administration of the estate of the late Jonathan Lougee, of Exeter, was granted to Ann, his widow, 9 April 1814 (Rockingham County Probate #4441, 42:85). A guardian was appointed for the younger son:

"Ann Lougee, widow, with Benjamin Clark, gentleman, and John Lougee, cabinet maker, all of Exeter, as her sureties, was chosen, 31 Oct. 1814, as the guardian of William F. Lougee, over fourteen and son of Jonathan F. Lougee, deceased, whose last will and testament she is the widow clearly as Ann. There is no other document in the file (ibid., 9178)."

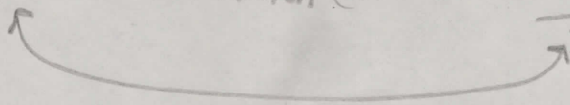
