The following brief record of the Olmstead family was not designed for publication, but merely for the benefit of that branch of the family with which the author is connected. To him belongs the credit of collecting the various facts contained herein. However, this little volume will be found interesting and useful to many whose connection is more remote.

The oldest tradition we have of the family is that they originated in Germany, and the exact date of their leaving there is not known; but in the early part of the sixteenth century they were settled at Cambridge in England, and the old colony records of New England show that in 1632, twelve years after the first landing of the pilgrims on Plymouth rock, Mass., they emigrated to America.

## JAMES OLMSTEAD.

Came to Boston, Mass., in the ship Lyon, from London, England, September 16, 1632. He was received a freeman. Settled at Cambridge, Mass., and filled the office constable there for some years. He removed to Hartford, Conn., in 1636, of which he was an original proprietor, with large lots of land, his will and inventory showing a comfortable property. He died Sept. 18, 1640.

NEHEMIAH OLMSTEAD, son of James (p. 1).

Removed to Fairfield, Conn., and was a military officer there A. D. 1657. From him probably descended the families of that name in Easton, Weston, Munroe and Danbury.

JOHN OLMSTEAD, nephew of James (p. 1).

Settled at Norwich, Conn., lived and died there. He left no issue, and his property was inherited by the children of his brother Richard.

#### THE OLMSTEAD FAMILY.

RICHARD OLMSTEAD, nephew of James (p. 1).

He with his uncle was one of the original proprietors of Hartford, Conn., A. D. 1639. Removed to Norwalk, Conn., A. D. 1651, of which he was (with others from Hartford and other places) a purchaser of the township from Roger Ludlow Esq. of Fairfield, June 19, 1650. (See page 32 of Dr. Hall's work on Norwalk). In the town he was first in military command. In A. D. 1653 he was a representative to the general assembly May session, and a dozen other sessions, until A. D. 1679. He was a commissioner of the peace, i. e., town judge. He seems to have enjoyed the public confidence until the end of life.
