

I am reaching out to you for help with finding my ancestors, the Prescott family originally from Kensington, NH. They moved to Gilmanton in the late 1700's.

I am seeking information on Jonathan Prescott III, an American Patriot Veteran who apparently died on the 10th of December 1809 and could be buried in SMHC within Gilmanton. His wife is Rachael Clifford Prescott who would also be buried in Gilmanton. His Son, Timothy Prescott and his wife Annah Locke Prescott are infact buried in SMHC Sept 12, 1845 and I will have to look through my notes for her burial date. Beside them is their son Jonathan Prescott and his wife Miranda Clough Prescott. Timothy's son, Jonathan died on May 23, 1881 and Miranda died on September 24, 1901. All four grave stones are together and to the right end where the old cemetery end of SMHC started.

Thomas Tush. In 1776 He went to NY under Capt. William Prescott & Col. Thomas Tush. He was at West Point and other places in NY State up to 1780. The last year he served under Capt. Henry Butler & Col. Thomas Bartlett. He moved his family to Gilmanton, NH in 1793
