My name is Charles H. Pervier of Scarborough, Maine. I am doing research on my family and am in hope of finding documents related to the birth, marriage and death of my great-great grand father, Benjamin Pervier (III), born in 1832 at Gilmanton, he married Frances Hubbell on June 18, 1861 in Gilmanton, and later died on June 3, 1864 while serving in the Union Army at Cold Harbor, VA.

This Benjamin was the son of Benjamin Pervier (II) born Apr 18, 1803 also in Gilmanton, NH. Benjamin II married Sarah Truell on Mar 29, 1826 in Salisbury, NH and died on Aug 30, 1872 in Highgate, VT.

The first Benjamin in this series :- ) was born in 1753 in Hampton Falls, NH. He married Mary (or Sally ?) Mann on Dec 16, 1784 at Kensington, NH. He died at Salisbury, NH on Feb 25, 1784

I provide all of this information in hopes that you can assist me in viewing the original documents related especially to Benjamins II and III. If you do not possess these records could you please advise me as to where I may go to see them and possibly obtain copies. I am willing and able to personally appear at any location at any time to view these documents.
