Here is the PDF file I submitted to the SAR to add Nathaniel as one of my patriot ancestors. You are welcome to print or copy any or all of it that you like. I believe Nathaniel is my 6th great grandfather.

Nathaniel was a Captain in Colonel Thomas Stickney's Regiment, General Starke's brigade of the NH militia.

If you'd like to go further back, I have 4 more generations but no hard proof like I do for SAR.

Nathaniel's dad was Humphrey, born in 1699 in Exeter and died in 1770 in Brentwood, NH.

Nathaniel's grandfather was Thomas, born in 1672 and died in 1753, both in Exeter

Nathaniel's great grandfather was also Humphrey, born in 1635 and died in 1698, both in Exeter.

Nathaniel's second great grandfather was Thomas (see a theme here?) born in 1595 and died in 1643. Thomas was born in England, arrived in America from Scotland in 1633, and died in Exeter, NH. He was married to Ann in 1627 in England.

Last will and Testament of George J. Wilson.

Know all men by these presents that I, George J. Wilson, of Ohio, County of St. Clair, do hereby make, declare and publish this my last will and Testament hereby expressly revoking any and all former expressed wishes regarding the disposition of my property and estate whatsoever the form thereof.

1. It is my will, and I especially direct that such debts as I may be owing at the time of my death, together with all proper and necessary expenses of my last sickness, be first paid out of my estate.

2. It is my will, and I give devise and bequeath unto my sister, Abbie J. Wilson, as her sole separate and individual property, an estate for and during her natural life in and to that certain tract of sixty acres of land located in St. Charles, Missouri, now held as my home, and more particularly described as the East half of the North East quarter of Section Ten, in Township Thirtynine, Range Twentyseven, less Twenty acres off North End of said half quarter Section - said Abbie J. Wilson to have the sole and exclusive use and right of possession of said tract of land and all rents and profits therefrom, out of which she will be expected to pay the taxes thereon and the necessary right and estate in such tract of land after the death of my said sister Abbie, to vest in my grand children Roy H. Pyeatt, Elsie Pyeatt, and Donald Pyeatt, children of my deceased daughter Belle.

3. It is my will, and I give devise and bequeath all the residue of my property and estate over and above the payment of my debts and the said life estate to my sister Abbie, to my said sister, Abbie J. Wilson, in trust for the use and benefit of my said grand children Roy H. Elsie and Donald Pyeatt, and the terms of this trust are these: That all such personal and real property as at my death is not bringing income shall as early as practicable be turned into money and after provision for or for want of, all lawful debts and expenses such moneys to be by my executors paid over to said Abbie J. Wilson trustee. Such moneys

and I direct that said Ellen & Hilson shall succeed to said trust as it then shall stand, possessing thereby all the powers, and having all the rights, as such trustee herein given to said Albert J. Hilson.

4. I name and appoint as the Executor of this ~~my~~ will S. C. Stultwort, of Appleton City, Missouri.

Within one year from the day each of said grand children reaches the age of twenty one years, his proper share in value at a fair estimate of the said trust estate then remaining unexpended (are that if all three be living) shall be paid over to such grand child or there may be a division of such unexpended trust property in the proper share in kind delivered to such grand child, or it may be partly in money and partly in property, all as the said trustee or her successor shall determine. This however, is not to give said grand children, or either of them any right in said sixty acre tract until the death of my said sister Abbie. Upon her death if before my said grand children reach twenty one years of age, the said sixty acres shall be and become trust property upon the same terms, conditions, and powers as hereinafter specified.
