Later in life, he lived in Lansdale, PA (near family) and the last 21 years in Rutland, MA (also near family).

Bill was involved in many hobbies during his lifetime, including motorcycling, hang gliding, ham radios, building remote control model airplanes, and later in life, flight simulator where he learned real flight training by computer gaming. One of his greatest passions became studying the Holy Bible along with study of related scriptures, reading every night for more than 35 years. Additionally, he was very musically inclined and self-taught, in guitar, and piano.
