After school, Debi worked for a variety of employers, including the NH Department of Transportation and Hills' Sporting Goods. Debi was most recently employed by Brine's ESC Team Sales (previously Everett Team Sports) in Concord, where her love of sports and outgoing personality were valuable assets.

She was baptized and raised in the Catholic church, later becoming a

member of Concordia Lutheran Church in Concord.

Debi had wonderful memories of her childhood days, spending time with her maternal grandparents on the campus of St. Paul's School.

She was "daddy's little girl" and adored her father, "Tarzan" Healy. Debi grew up on the courts of Bow Brook Tennis Club and she and her father played in many father-daughter tennis tournaments. She was a championship-caliber player for the Concord High School tennis team.

Her sense of humor and amazing gift for making people feel welcome brought her many friends. This was never more evident than at the recent tribute night for Debi sponsored by the Red Blazer Restaurant and Pub. Hundreds of well-wishers attended to show their support and love for Debi.

She was always happy and content when she was able to work on her tan at the beach. But, her greatest joy was her family. She was a devoted and extremely loving mother, and she had a very special relationship as "Bunne" with her granddaughter. She delighted in remembering Jay's time at New Hampton School and diminutive Lindsey's toughness on the soccer field. Although Debi's illness prevented her from attending Camryn's "graduation" from pre-school, she proudly displayed the cap & gown photo and dreamed of the great things to come in her granddaughter's life.

Debi is survived by her son Justin (Jay) A. Hauser of Henniker; her daughter Lindsey E. Hauser and her granddaughter Camryn R. Paiement, both of Gilmanton.
