GILMANTON - Daniel Warren Webster, recently of Concord, passed away peacefully on March 11, 2017. He was born in Laconia on April 30, 1929. Danny was the son of William Webster and Marjorie (Pitman) Webster, and brother of Eleanor. Danny married the love of his life, Barbara (Andrew) Webster, in 1990.

Danny graduated from Pittsfield High School in 1946. He served in the U.S. [Army](#) from 1946-1948, serving in Japan at the end of WWII. Following his service, he attended the Concord School of Business and graduated with a degree in Accounting. He worked at Concord Lumber Co. before going to work for the State of NH, where he worked as an Auditor for the Department of Health and Human Services, retiring in 1994.
