

Sargeant Charles W. Levitt of Gilmanton, N.H.

Enlisted in Mountain Infantry (Ski Troops) in Chicago, Illinois on Dec 11, 1941. Trained at Camp Hale, Colorado, Camp Carson and Monterey. Took part in the invasion of Kiska, Aleutian Islands. Sailed for Italian Alps in January 1945. Took part in Antack near Verona, Italy and was fatally wounded and died Feb 21, 1945. He received two silver stars for galantry in action and also the purple heart. He was serving in Co, I 87th Mountain Infantry 10th mountain Division. He was the son of Mr and Mrs Levitt, Gilmanton, N.H. He was born in Baltimore, Maryland Aug 12, 1923. Studied at Huntington, School, Boston. Brewster Academy, Wolfeboro, N.H. and Illinois Tec. Chicago, Ill..

Sargeant Duncan A. Geddes of Gilmanton, N.H.

Inducted July 10, 1943 at Manchester, N.H. Trained as an Aviation student student of Springfield Collage, Massachusetts Armours School at Buckley Field, Colorado; Gunnery School at Harlingen, Texas where he was awarded his gunners wings and Corporal strips. Served at Chattam Field for crew training. HAd his P.O.E. November 1944. Reported missing in action Feb, 17, 1945 while on a mission to Aschoffenburg, Germany as a member of the 788th Bombardment Squadron 467th Bombardment Group 8th Airforce. Son of Mr and Mrs John A. Geddes, Gilmanton, N.H.
