Saterday night, May 8. Davis steped in at 11:30 P.M. He said he was going to get caretaker down at Wings. Claims that said a caretaker ran off with his girls last year. I called Malcolm Locke. to tell him to keep out of camp. Also called Berk so he could have his head aches.

I could go on endlessly pointing out the family tricks; but it doesn't remedy the situation. No matter which way you turn: taxpayer will be stuck with the bill.

If you need anymore evidence ask what Ellen is doing down home so much. Who takes care of children when they go on their Saterday rides.
