

FROM THE WILL OF ISAIAH S. ROBINSON

Dated April 17, 1900

From the records of the Probate Court of Suffolk County, Mass.

"The remainder to be divided thus:

Ten thousand dollars, if so much shall remain, I give to the town of Gilmanton, New Hampshire, to be preserved as a fund known as the Isaiah S. Robinson fund, the interest of which sum shall be expended yearly by the selectmen for the improvement of Gilmanton Iron Works, the principal to be held in trust by the selectmen of the town."

Note: Of the amount left by Isaiah Robinson, five hundred dollars had to be paid as inheritance tax; making the net capital of the fund \$9500.
